- What to do when a client has a tattoo:

it is very important as aesthetic therapist to take precaution when treating a client with a tattoo in your laser hair removal session. at all times you will color in the tattoo (if small enough) with a white pencil to discolour it. thereafter you will cover the tattoo with a non-pigmented paper and tape it close with a none color tape). the reason being that the laser Diode is attracted to color pigment, so while treating the hairs on the clients said body area and there is a tattoo and you work over it you will cause a burn, distort the tattoo resulting in a very unhappy client.

- what to do when a client has patches of hair growing back:

this is a result of the aesthetic therapist not working in said grids and accumulating the right energy for the grid size, as well as not overlapping 1cm over each grid to make sure you have covered all areas.

- why is it important to never lift the SHR hand piece while treating?

lifting the SHR hand piece while treating will result in a burn. as the energy distributed loses contact with the skin and causes a sharp zap or disruption of current. this is very unpleasant for the client. as an aesthetic therapist you should at all times ensure that the hand piece is flat on the clients surface. for boney areas ensure you move around and follow a pattern to avoid lifting during treatment.

- what do you do when you have an under aged client:

often we will get enquiries for young girls whose parents are sending them for laser. this could be for a number of reasons, either religion or that they are being teased at school. we are able to treat these young clients, as long as: the parent has given consent and signed on behalf of their child. The parent needs to be present in the room. to give your client optimum comfort you can provide them with a magazine/ fone/tablet to occupy their thoughts and so they can feel comfortable. For your settings its advised to used a lower fluence with a longer accumulated energy to avoid sensitivity for the young client.

- what do you do with when a client requests their brows to be lasered?

some of the TLB clinics have a 1cm hand piece which allows for better access to their hard to work areas. Other TLB clinics only have the 2cm hand piece. in this case it is advised to recommend electrolysis for your client. for the reason that is more accurate and you can shape the brow according to how the client would like it. should the client only ask for unibrow you can offer HR on the middle of the brows.
